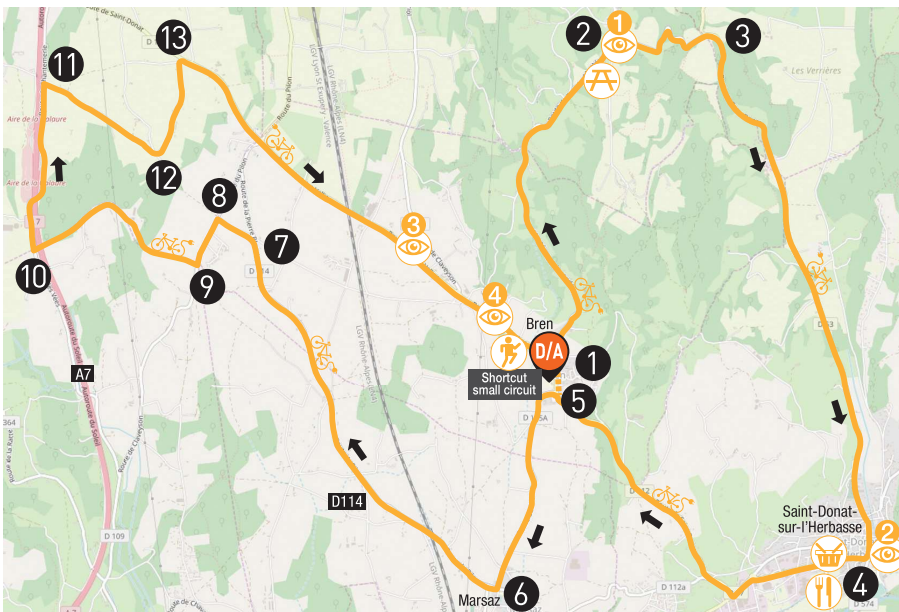
A WATER COUNTRY [BREN]

Hills and Valleys

A beautiful scenic route, with the first part overlooking the Vercors mountain range, takes you to the charming church of Saint-Andéol then downward towards Saint-Donat with a favourite stopping point. The final section offers a bucolic atmosphere as you travel through truffle oak trees and agricultural land.

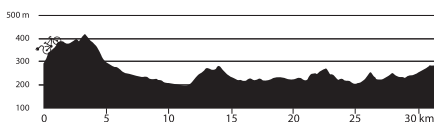

ROADBOOK

- 1 **0 km** From the church car park follow the road going up to Saint-Andéol.
- 2 **3,7 km** On entering Saint-Andéol turn right to Saint-Donat.
- 3 **5 km** On the main road turn right towards Saint-Donat.
- 4 **10,3 km** In Saint-Donat follow the signs to Saint-Vallier.
- 5 **14,2 km** As you enter Bren turn left to Marsaz.
- 6 **16,2 km** In Marsaz turn right onto the D114 and straight on for 4km.
- 7 **20,3 km** Take the small road on the left (careful! No signs).
- 8 **20,6 km** Turn left onto the main road opposite "chemin Lafay".
- 9 **21,1 km** Take the first road on the right "chemin de Bornarin".
- 10 **23,1 km** Turn right after passing the motorway.
- 11 **25 km** Turn right onto "chemin de Lafay".
- 12 **26,2 km** Turn left onto the road "Pied Buisson".
- 13 **27,1 km** Turn right onto the main road taking you back to Bren.

1 SAINT-ANDEOL PRIORY : On a hillock discover a charming small Roman church. Just below, a few picnic tables make it worth stopping a while to take in the stunning view of the Vercors mountain range.

2 DELPHINAL PALACE IN SAINT-DONAT : So much heritage to see in the historical heart of Saint-Donat makes you want to come back again and again : the Collegiate Church and its Organ, the Priory and the XII-century Roman Cloister.

3 THE PARROT PARK (PARC DES PERROQUETS) : A family, its passion and unusual family history along with amazing birds all make it an out of the ordinary place to enjoy yourselves.

4 SAINT-JOSEPH HONEY FARM : The bees are all considered queens at Emmanuelle and Bruno's farm ! Come and forage amongst their nectars, the fruit of their 500 beehives : Honey, royal jelly, pollen, bee glue.

A LITTLE BONUS

In Bren there is a rich heritage round water worth seeing. Follow the signs "chemin des Fontaines".
