


# THE DOLCIA VIA SAINT-LAURENT-DU-PAPE

## **ROADBOOK**

## DAY 1

- 1 0 km Go along the Dolce Via to Le Chevlard.
- 2 45 km Fork onto the alternative route taking you to Lamastre.
- 3 60 km Get on board the Mastrou stream train taking you down to the Doux Valley.
- **40 60 km** Go to Saint-Jean-de-Muzols and pick up the ViaRhôna to Tournon-sur-Rhône.

### DAY 2

- 6 0 km Continue on the ViaRhôna to
- 6 12,6 km Leave the cycling track turning right onto the D86 and continue a few kilometres to Châteaubourg.
- 7 13,4 km Go through the village and onto the "blue" trail.
- 8 28 km Pick up the ViaRhôna and follow the signs to La Voulte.
- 9 43 km Before crossing the river Eyrieux leave the ViaRhôna towards Saint-Laurent-du-Pape going through Beauchastel.

Bike \_\_\_\_ Train



1 TRAIN DE L'ARDÈCHE (STEAM TRAIN) : Are you ready to go back in time? From the station in Tournon/St-Jean you can hear the steam train whistling in the heart of the Doux Gorges. Get on board the "Mastrou" (special compartment for bikes) to Tournon (on booking only).

2 THE BLUE TRAIL: A pleasant link on this alternative route to the ViaRhôna, avoiding the centre of Valence and offering a more refreshing and shady track than the embankments of the Rhône river.

3 CASTLE OF CRUSSOL: To the south of Tournon facing Valence, a medieval citadel seems to withstand time. Its exceptional panoramic view adds even more to the visit.

4 BEAUCHASTEL: Abandoned long ago, with its 1001 narrow streets, dedicated to art of all kinds, a lot of work has been undertaken to restore the village.



1 LES AZALÉES (Hotel and restaurant): The owner is a cycling fan so, no need to say, you'll find everything you need here for a stop during your 2 days on wheels.

The stopover: The two towns Tain/Tournon offer all facilities for sleeping and eating in an exceptional heritage area. How about an icecream on the river wharf to cool down!
