

Sur les chemins de la Clairette ...

AOC Clairette de Die

Clairette de Die is the most widely known and the oldest of all the AOCs in the Diois : it obtained the appellation in 1942. Muscat grape (75 % minimum) and Clairette grape (25% maximum) variety are used to produce this sparkling wine.

AOC Crémant de Die

This dry white sparkling wine is produced using the Clairette grape variety, the aligoté and muscat grapes are also part of its composition. An AOC since 1993, it is produced in accordance with the traditional method, with an initial fermentation in the vat and a second one in the bottle.


AOC Coteaux de Die

This still, dry white wine is produced using 100% clairette grapes. In common with the Crémant, it obtained its AOC appellation in 1993.



AOC Châtillon-en-Diois

This is the only still wine that is available in white (aligoté and chardonnay), red and rosé (gamay, pinot noir and syrah). It obtained its AOC appellation in 1975.


... Sous les Trois becs

Height difference +/- 160 m / age > 10 years old / time 1 hour 15 minutes

You are on the little village of **Saint-Sauveur-en-Diois** with 70 hectares of AOC vines growing on the slopes that surround the village. Clairette de Die has become the economic lung of the village. During this trail you will enjoy a wonderful observation point on the Trois Becs : Le Veyou (1589m) – Le Signal (1559m) - Roche Courbe (1549m). This trail follows the Drôme valley. The view is scattered of wooded hills. The trail is far away from big traffic lanes and entirely devoted to the Clairette de Die. The walk offers typical landscapes : fields, hamlets and vineyards. After the hamlet of Mouyons, you can discover the Glandasse Mountain and the back of Roche Courbe.

And not far away ...

Les Trois Becs and the Roche Courbe
The Signal and the Veyou, which reach around 1500m at their highest point, Saillans : its ancient village and its 12th century church, Plaine d'Aubenasson air field.



Itinerary of the Trail

Starting point :

From the roundabout west of Saillans, take the D93 in the direction of Die for 400 meters then the first road on the right in the direction of Saint-Sauveur-en-Diois. After 1.5 km, turn left onto the D579 which leads you to Saint-Sauveur.
