

THE KING OF RIVERS [GLUN]

An easy outing

The short cycling trail along the river Rhône is ideal for a family outing, mostly on safe, nature cycling routes. On the longer trail, amateur cyclists will be thrilled with the view after an uphill effort to Pic Saint-Romain.

Q Look out for

Nature route, chocolate, pogne brioche, lake, river Rhône, picturesque village, viewpoint.



ROADBOOK

- **1) 0 km** Go along the ViaRhôna to Tournon-sur-Rhône.
- 7,8 km Cross the footbridge onto the green route "Chabelet" heading towards Valence.
- 3 16,4 km Get back onto the ViaRhôna heading to Tournon and cross over the river Rhône and its canal again.
- 4 19,1 km Continue straight on on the main road.
- 5 20 km Turn left signed up Saint-Péray.
- **6 21,3 km** Turn right signed up Saint-Romain-de-Lerps.
- **7 26,3 km** Turn right at Combes onto "route de Combes".

- 8 29,1 km Turn right at the stop sign, continue to Pic de Lerps viewpoint then retrace your steps.
- **8** 30 km Back at the crossroads, follow signs to Saint-Sylvestre.
- 31,4 km Turn right onto "route de Plats" to the village.
- **10 35,9 km** Turn right after the church onto the main road to Mauves.
- **1) 43,2 km** Turn right at the stop sign leading into Mauves then continue through the village.
- **45,3 km** Turn left just before the railway line then return to Glun.

1 CITE DU CHOCOLAT VALRHONA: When you pass through Tain L'Hermitage and see ValRhôna Cité du Chocolat, you won't resist the chance for a bite of chocolate. A must, definitely not to be missed where chocolate won't hold any secrets for you anymore!

2 BASSIN DES MUSARDS: In its green setting this reservoir is a close neighbour to the river Rhône. Its vivid blue water makes it an ideal place for a family to stop for a break or relax and spend a pleasant moment.

(3) LA ROCHE-DE-GLUN: Once a fishing village it became an island when the dam was built by the company CNR.

Discover many surprises in this hamlet full of history such as ancient monuments, pebblestone houses, memories of Diane de Poitiers and Plomb Tower.

4 PIC SAINT ROMAIN: The uphill climb demands some effort before you get to the top, but what a view from there! On one side the Alpes unfold before your eyes and on the other the Monts des Vivarais seem endless.



PICNIC CORNER: The emerald green setting of the reservoir in Roche de Glun is ideal for stopping to have a bite.
