NYONS

Known as «le Petit Nice» or the «Tuscany of the Rhone-Alps region», the city enjoys privileged weather conditions. Nyons city is a perfect holiday destination thanks to its high rate of sunshine, mild winters, amazing luminosity, preserved landscapes and Terroir of high quality. Besides, a rich historical heritage whose main jewels are the Randonne Tower, the famous Romanesque Bridge and the Arcades Square completes the portrait. According to the late local novelist René Barjavel: «The only difference between Nyons and Paradise, is that in Nyons we are definitely alive.»



The starting point of the treasure hunt is located at the Tourist Board. As soon as you get out of the Board main entrance, turn right and walk along the building. Take the crosswalk in front of the drugstore. Then join Docteur Bourdongle Square, also called Place des Arcades. Cross the square and pay attention to details...

Take the first left after the square to join J-P André street: at the end of the street, you will find the «Fournil Barjavel» (Barjavel Bakery) 1. Keep on walking until you reach Buffaven Square. Head towards the City Hall to look for the six painted panels 2.

In front of the City Hall, turn on your right to reach Grands Forts street. Walk under the feudal castle to find the three sculpted blazons 3.

Take the stairs on your left and keep on

walking to join Petits Fort Street on your left. Walk past the laundry (on your left) and keep walking. You come up to Calvaire Square 4.

Cross the square to pass n°8 door and enjoy the view over Notre Dame de Bon Secours Chapel. Down the stairs, go front via Randonne Street, towards Chanoine François Square and Notre Dame de Bon Secours Chapel 5.

Get out of the square and walk down the street on the left of the chapel.

Be careful when getting down (dangerous slope)!

Go straight on Biffardel Street to enjoy the panoramic view over the Eygues Valley at the intersection.

On Biffardel Street, stay on your left to join Petits Forts Street. Walk past the fountain

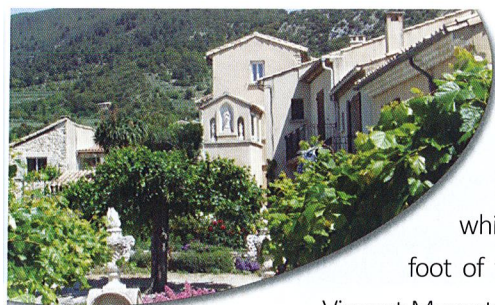
on your right, go down on your left, then on your right to reach Saint-Césaire Square. Cross the square and walk left on Pontias Street. Walk right onto Déportés Street. Then continue to the left to reach J-Laurent square and turn right on the Romanesque Bridge 6.

Get back on your steps and take the first left that goes down: it's Bas Bourgs Street. At the end of this street (at the intersection with Colonel Barrillon street), keep walking until you reach Autié Square. Cross this little square to discover the Church Saint-Vincent 7. Finally, take Resistance Street to get back to Doctor Bourdongle Square (or Place des Arcades) 8.

Back at the Tourist Board, ask for your «treasure»!

The Feudal Castle

Former feudal castle, the Castle of Nyons was built in the 8th century for the seigniorial administration which used to be located on the rock of Maupas, at the foot of the Forts district; it was built there to protect the St Vincent Monastery. The castle was extended until the 11th

century, in particular with the addition of Sarrasin towers: it then became an important mansion. In 1626, when the Nyons people bought back the seigneurie, it became a town property. Later in 1731, the castle was turned into a presbytery and sold at public auction in 1779. Restored from the early 1960s on, it is now a private property. The Grands Forts street passage and the coats of arms situated at the entrance of this passage are listed historical monuments.



The Notre Dame de Bon Secours Chapel

The Randonne Tower was built by the Baroness of Montauban in 1820.

Set up on a rock which dominated Nyons, this medieval architecture edifice used to be both a donjon and a military jail. Purchased by Abbot Francou, the tower was turned into a chapel. A 3.50m statue of The Virgin was elevated on top of a 3 level-arches pyramid. The building, renamed « Chapelle Notre Dame de Bon Secours », was inaugurated in 1863. Every August 15, the Randonne Tower is celebrated on the occasion of a big fest.

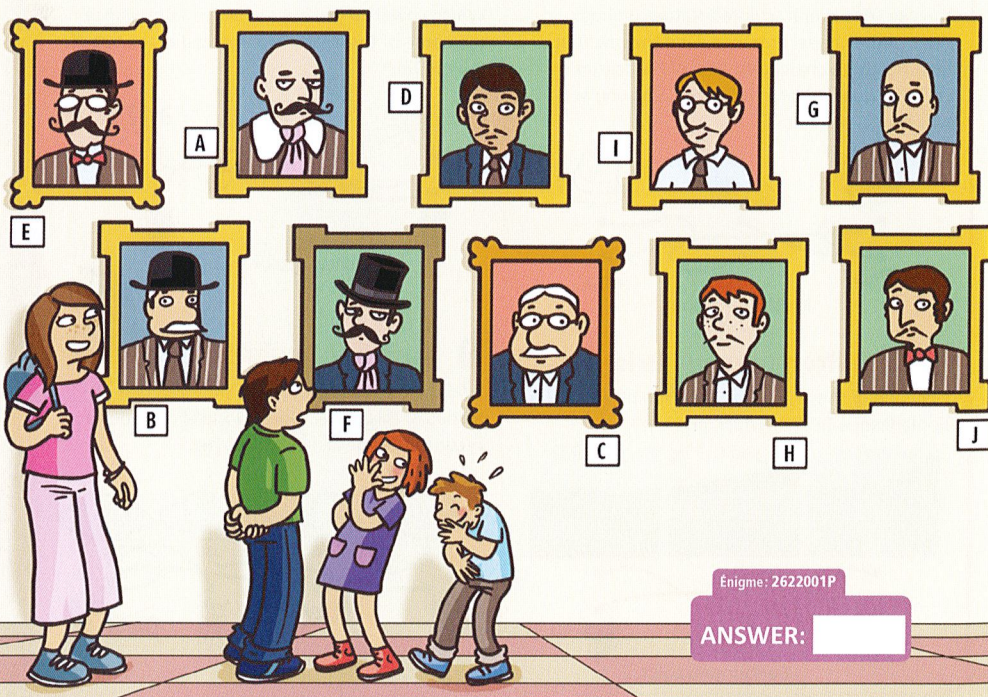

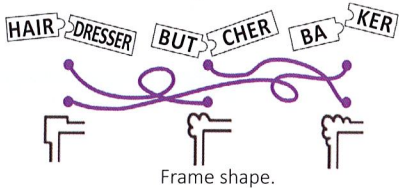

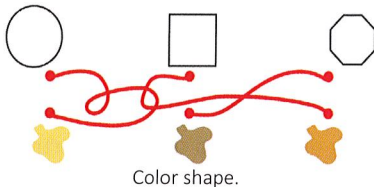

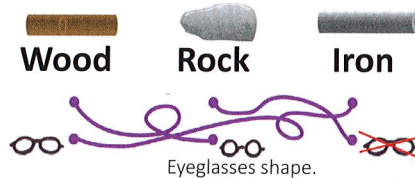

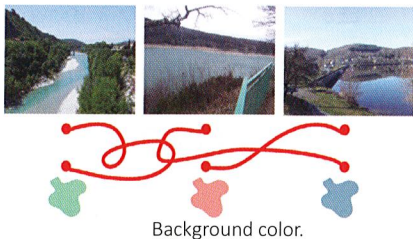

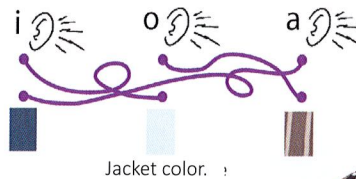

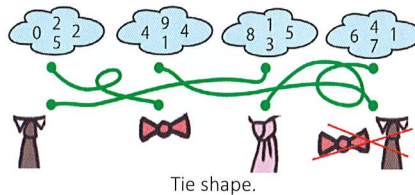

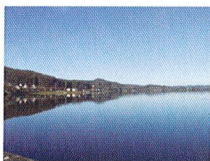

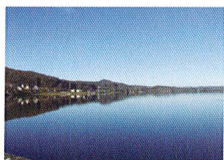
